

## ***RPA Memorial Scholarship Program***

***In an effort to provide a benefit to our members and their families and in recognition of the service of the deceased members of our Association, in 1998 the President and the Executive Board of Officers elected to start this RPA Scholarship Program.***

### ***Applications:***

Available in our Newsletter, on our website, or may be obtained by contacting the RPA Office. Must be completed on the RPA provided application or an exact machine duplicate in size and content. Non-conforming applications will be discarded.

### ***Sponsorship:***

Applicants must be sponsored by an active RPA member in good standing for the current year, or by a widow or widower of a deceased member, who was in good standing during the year of death.

### ***Eligibility:***

A son, daughter or grandchild of an active or deceased member of this association must be attending or enrolled in a College, University, or College Level Trade or Technical School on a full time basis (12+credits) for the school year. **Student must produce an official transcript from their College Admissions Office if they are selected.**

### ***One Entry per Applicant:***

Only one application per applicant is permitted. If more than one application is received for the same applicant, the additional application for that applicant will be discarded.

### ***Applicants Same Family:***

Each eligible member of a family may participate. However, **only one scholarship will be awarded per sponsor each year, to the family member first drawn.**

### ***Scholarship Amounts:***

The RPA Executive Board of Officers has authorized the awarding of RPA scholarships, each in the name of a deceased past President and each in the amount of \$500.00. Other Scholarships donated by

individuals or companies will be in the amount authorized. The larger denomination scholarships will be the first drawn in the lottery.

***Verification of Attendance:***

Winners will be required to verify school enrollment in a **timely fashion:** (60) sixty days after receiving notification of such Scholarship. If applicant fails to respond in a timely manner, he or she may lose the right to the said Scholarship. Scholarship would then be awarded to the next applicant in line.

***Number of Scholarships:***

The exact number of scholarships to be awarded is unknown at this time. Presently there are no less than 12 scholarships authorized. If additional scholarships are donated, they will be added.

***Scholarship Drawings:***

Will be on a lottery basis in order to give each applicant an equal chance of selection. Scholarship Awards will be drawn at the RPA General Meeting on the third Thursday during the month of January each year by the Scholarship Committee and viewed by the membership in attendance.

**All scholarship applications must be received by that date to participate in drawing.**

***Scholarship Committee:***

Chairman and two Co-Chairmen from the RPA Executive Board appointed by the RPA President.

**Application must be made on this form (see next page) or an exact machine duplicate in size and content or form received from RPA Office. More than one entry in the same applicant's name or entries not conforming to the required size and content will be discarded. Applications must be received prior to the Third Thursday of January's General Meeting, at which time drawing will be held.**
